On 1-4-2005 at 1:45pm Dallas Mallory came to the courthouse to be interviewed by Prosecuting Attorney Kevin Crane and myself about what he remembered on Halloween night, 10-31-2001. Mallory, in October 2001 was living with his father at 6400 Gateway Blvd, Columbia Mo.

Mallory said that in October 2001, he worked at the Forum Cleaners in the Forum Shopping Center. He worked from 7am to 3pm Monday through Friday. Mallory remembers that his father drove him to work on 10-31-2001. Mallory walked to Schnucks Grocery Store during the day and bought a fifth of Captain Morgan and a bottle of Coke. Mallory planned to go out on Halloween after he got off work at the cleaner.

Mallory got off work at 3pm so before he left the business he took a drink of the Captain Morgan. He stated that he did not remember anyone picking him up from work and said that it is possible that he drove himself.

Mallory eventually went to a party at Ryan Swilling's house on Highridge Dr. Mallory stated that he did not recall anyone driving him there and that he may have driven himself to the Swilling party. Mallory said that he remembers that he saw Chuck Erickson at Swilling's but not Ferguson. Mallory said that he was dressed as a police officer for Halloween and planned to go down to the Blue Note bar for the costume contest later. The police broke up the party at Swilling's house and Mallory remembers talking to a police officer abut Mallory's police costume. Mallory said that he did not remember anyone driving with him to the Blue Note.

Mallory said after he left the Swilling party he went down to the Blue Note bar on Ninth Street. He went inside and was there until the bar closed. He thinks he was by himself and remembers drinking shots of Jagermeister at the bar downstairs. He stayed until the lights came on and the bar staff asked everyone to leave. He did not see Erickson or Ferguson at the Blue Note but did hang around outside the bar talking to people on the sidewalk. Mallory is not sure how long he was outside the Blue Note.

Mallory said that after leaving the Blue Note he saw Ryan Ferguson and Chuck Erickson together and remembers Erickson "running up" and saying something to the affect "we beat someone down". Mallory does not remember anyone driving him from the Blue Note.

Mallory believes that he stayed at his father's house that night at 6400 Gateway Blvd.
