## NARRATIVE

While reviewing the the facts of the case I decided to contact Dallas Mallory #374236  
 to do a follow up interview. He agreed to come into my office and meet with me.  
 on 9/14/04.

about 10: 00AM Dallas repeated to Detective Westbrook and me what he had  
 originally told Westbrook during the March '04 interview. Mallory recalled it  
 was Halloween, '01. He was working at the Forum Cleaners. When he got off work  
 he changed his clothes into his "police officer" costume.

later that evening he attended a party at Blue Note, still dressed as a police  
 officer. He spent most of the evening in and out of the bar. He doesn't  
 remember seeing either Ferguson or Erickson at the Blue Note.

Mallory said he knows the two from High School. He didn't really hang with  
 them because they were both a couple of grade levels lower than himself. I  
 asked if he has talked to them since their high school days and he said he has  
 on several occasions but has never considered either of them to be friends.

Dallas said that after the Blue Note closed on the night in question, he left.  
 He can not say exactly where he was but remembers seeing Erickson. He remembers  
 Erickson being figity and pushy, saying something about a "fight."

Westbrook asked exactly what Erickson said about the "fight." Dallas said he  
 can't recall the exact wording but remembers Erickson saying something about a  
 physical altercation.

Westbrook reminded Dallas that Dallas had originally reported to the police  
 that Erickson told Dallas, "we beat someone down." Dallas agreed that was the

statement he heard Erickson make.

We asked Dallas if there were two girls with Dallas during that encounter with Erickson. He said he can't remember. We asked if Ferguson was with Erickson and he said he didn't see Ferguson.

We asked Dallas exactly where the encounter occurred. He said somewhere close to the downtown area but can't remember exactly where.
