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At 10:30 AM I displayed a Miranda rights card from my file and read ICKSON his Miranda rights directly from this card. After reading ERICKSON Miranda rights, he stated he understood and was willing to speak with us. asked ERICKSON to go over the events that occurred on the night in question taining to the murder of Kent HEITHOLT.

ERICKSON began by telling us a short time, maybe one week or two weeks or to murder he and FERGUSON had been arrested for minor in possession. He d this incident occurred somewhere around West Blvd, but he was uncertain on exact location. When checking the Columbia Police Dept in house records wed ERICKSON and FERGUSON were arrested on 09/28/01 at West Blvd and Ash for uor law violation. ERICKSON stated FERGUSON was extremely upset with the ice department for arresting him, and in fact during that night while they e being held in an interview room, FERGUSON had urinated in a trash can le in custody at the Columbia Police Dept.

On Halloween night of 2001, ERICKSON stated he had gone to a party at a ject by the name of Ryan SWILLINGS. ERICKSON stated while at the party he done one line of cocaine, and during the event of the party, police had to the residence and broke the party up. ERICKSON stated he started cing, and at that time he was approached by Ryan FERGUSON in Ryan's Mercedes Leave the party. He stated FERGUSON picked him up, and they began to leave the party. CKSON states he was dressed in a 70's style costume wearing bell bottom is, but he stated FERGUSON was not wearing a costume. While driving in SUSON'S car, he stated FERGUSON was called by either his sister, or FERGUSON ed his sister, and FERGUSON told him they were giong to be able to get into By George night club. ERICKSON stated they were going to meet Ryan's er, and a friend of hers at the bar, and prior to going to the bar, KSON went back to his residence and changed clothes before he and FERGUSON to By George.

When they arrived at the bar, ERICKSON attempted to describe to us e FERGUSON had parked his car. He was not certain, therefore we printed an all photograph of the downtown off the internet. ERICKSON looked at this ograph and when I directed his attention to the By George nightclub, KSON pointed to North First Street. ERICKSON stated FERGUSON parked on h First Street facing north on the east side of the road. He stated he ed just south of East Walnut on the west side of the Mizzou Credit Union ing lot.

When I asked what Ryan's sister's friends name was, ERICKSON stated he is not tell what her name was because he did not remember. ERICKSON stated he could remember was she was an Asian female; but did not know what her was. ERICKSON stated he and FERGUSON were able to gain entry into the colub even though they were 17 years old. He stated there was a large

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ouncer who was a white male who allowed he and all the other individuals into me bar.

ERICKSON advised us while he was at his house changing, prior to going to george, when he came back out to the vehicle of FERGUSON'S, FERGUSON was on he phone with a female by the name of Holly ADMIRE. He stated this phone call as approximately midnight.

ERICKSON stated while they were in the bar, he did have some money and did FERGUSON. According to ERICKSON, he and FERGUSON ran out of money, and RGUSON continually went to his sister to obtain more money. ERICKSON states RGUSON went to his sister at least once, maybe 2 or 3 times more after that. one point, ERICKSON stated FERGUSON'S sister cut them off and would not low them to borrow any more money. FERGUSON and ERICKSON then decided to ave the bar and according to ERICKSON, when they left the bar, the party at e bar was "still going strong." ERICKSON stated when they got to FERGUSON'S r, he stated he wanted to go home, but FERGUSON stated they needed more money, nd they were going to have to "rob someone." While they were talking about , ERICKSON stated he was under the impression they were talking about doing a ck pocket on someone. At that time ERICKSON stated FERGUSON came up with the ea of taking something with them because he felt like they were younger, and uld need something to help themselves.

ERICKSON stated at that time FERGUSON got into the trunk of his reedes Benz and removed what he described as a tire iron or tire tool from trunk. He stated FERGUSON immediately handed this tire tool/iron to him. ICKSON could not be specific on what this tire tool was. He stated to the st of his knowledge and his memory, it had something to do with the jack stem or something to do with taking off tires but that is all he could nember about it. ERICKSON stated FERGUSON removed the tire iron from the link as if it was right inside the trunk and available. He stated FERGUSON inot have to move anything or lift anything to remove this tire iron from their vehicle.

ERICKSON stated at that time both of them began to walk downtown cause they needed to get away from the By George bar area if they were going rob anybody. When asked why they would have to be away from that location, just stated they felt like they needed to be away from there so they could back into the bar later on. When we asked again why they took the tire l/iron with them, ERICKSON stated their thinking was they might need to use sitem because things might get out of hand. ERICKSON stated FERGUSON told they needed a weapon, and they got the tool in case things "got fucked up."

We asked ERICKSON to be more specific about the conversation about

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Staining the weapon. He stated they were standing on the passenger side of ERGUSON'S vehicle when this conversation occurred. ERICKSON stated when ERGUSON brought up the conversation about the weapon, FERGUSON told him to come here" and he stated FERGUSON stated they needed a weapon. He stated he bened the trunk, handed him the tire tool, and then said, "We can use this." ERGUSON then directed ERICKSON to walk towards downtown, and they began to alk in an easterly direction from First and Ash.

ERICKSON stated they did not see anyone until they crossed Providence and, and they saw the victim (Kent HEITHOLT) in the back parking lot of the plumbia Tribune. ERICKSON stated they hid behind what he thought was imposters as they watched the victim (HEITHOLT) in the parking lot. He said se victim (HEITHOLT) was outside of his vehicle.

ERICKSON stated while they were hiding behind the dumpster enclosure, RGUSON looked at him and stated, "We need to do this. We need to get this er with." He stated FERGUSON looked at him and said, "You need to hit him." ICKSON stated at that point he ran towards HEITHOLT and hit him in the head th the weapon. ERICKSON stated HEITHOLT had his back towards him, and he ated he landed the blow in the back of his head. He stated he may have hit m more than once. He stated while he was hitting HEITHOLT in the head, RGUSON was standing to his right and behind him. ERICKSON stated he ntinued to strike HEITHOLT in the head with the tool until the victim went to e ground. ERICKSON stated HEITHOLT staggered at first, and when he went to the ound, he stopped hitting him. ERICKSON stated HEITHOLT could not go anywhere cause he was pinned between the open door of the car and the car itself.

ERICKSON stated HEITHOLT made a horrible noise that he described as a an, and when he saw the blood, he went and sat on a wall directly across from are they had attacked HEITHOLT. ERICKSON stated he put his head in his hands, and when he looked up, he saw HEITHOLT was face down on the concrete, and he id FERGUSON was on top of him. He stated FERGUSON had what he believed to be a left foot in the shoulder area of HEITHOLT'S back.

We asked what FERGUSON was doing, and he stated he was "strangling him. ERICKSON stated FERGUSON was strangling him with his belt. He stated &GUSON had his belt around his neck, and was pulling it back by one strap of belt. The way ERICKSON described it was the belt was wrapped around THOLT'S neck by the belt being looped through the belt buckle. He felt the kle was up against the victim's neck, and FERGUSON was pulling back on the strap causing the injuries to HEITHOLT'S neck.

ERICKSON stated at that point is when he got up and pushed FERGUSON off the victim, and removed the belt from the victim's neck. At that time we eruppted ERICKSON and asked how HEITHOLT'S hands were injured, because they

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ere injured on the back of his hands as if he had struck something with his ands, or as if he fought back.

ERICKSON stated at no time did the victim fight back or strike them in my way. ERICKSON stated he thought the victim had kicked him in the testicles, but he stated he was unsure about that now. ERICKSON stated when he was triking HEITHOLT in the head with the iron tire tool, HEITHOLT had placed his ands on top of his head to protect himself and thought that was possibly the many way HEITHOLT'S hands could have been injured. ERICKSON continued to state mat he and FERGUSON saw some people come out the back door of the Tribune. He mated they said something but he did not remember what it was. ERICKSON mated he told them to go get help because somebody was hurt, but he stated ERGUSON said nothing.

ERICKSON stated he began to panic, thinking about the things they had suched and picked up that belonged to HEITHOLT. I asked what were the items sey had touched or taken from the scene. ERICKSON stated he knew they touched the victim's cellphone because it was on the concrete in the drive when he was soking around. He stated they took the victim's keys and he felt FERGUSON had the victim's wallet. ERICKSON stated he took the belt with him when ey left the scene. Also removed from the victim was the victim's wrist watch. According to ERICKSON, Ryan FERGUSON had taken the watch, the keys and the ol with him, and the keys were taken from the victim's pants pocket. ICKSON stated the only thing he removed from the scene was the tool that was ed to strike the victim in the head.

According to ERICKSON, when they began to run from the scene, they left e opposite direction from where they came. ERICKSON stated that they ran wards Broadway and ran behind the Broadway Diner on south Fourth Street. ated after running southbound past the Diner, they began to run in a westerly rection across and through Flat Brank creek. ERICKSON said he stopped and shed his hands in the creek becaue they had blood on them. He stated they ne out on the north side of the convenience store located at Providence and cust. He stated there in the intersection, he saw Dallas MALLORY sitting 1thbound at the stop light at Providence and Locust. ERICKSON stated there re 2 females in the vehicle, but he did not know who they were. [CKSON stated he does not understand how MALLORY could not have seen FERGUSON, cause FERGUSON was standing directly behind him, or so he thought when they used to talk to MALLORY. ERICKSON stated when they heard the sirens, and saw : vehicles going back to their right which was towards the Columbia Tribune, knew the police had been notified. He stated he specifically told Dallas LORY they had just beat somebody down behind the Tribune. He stated at that e MALLORY took off when he heard the sirens. ERICKSON stated both he and GUSON ran through the Osco parking lot traveling in the direction of .GUSON'S car.

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We stopped ERICKSON and asked him if he had the belt in his hand when talked to Dallas MALLORY, and he stated he did. He stated Ryan had the tool, watch and the keys.

When they reached FERGUSON'S vehicle, FERGUSON opened up the trunk and the keys, the tool and the watch and put them in a plastic Kroger style opping bag. ERICKSON stated this bag was made out of plastic. He stated the lt was also placed in this plastic bag. ERICKSON stated he knows he had the ctim's blood on his shirt, therefore, he put his coat on over his shirt, and ey then went back into the bar at By George. ERICKSON said he pretty much t alone in the bar by himself until it was time to go and FERGUSON came and t him and stated they all left with the crowd. He stated they waited because ere was a police car outside pertaining to something going on on the parking t.

ERICKSON then told us that prior to going and committing the robbery, RGUSON had contacted a subject by the name of Brian DUNN. ERICKSON stated is phone call was made after they left the bar and prior to going to commit e robbery. He stated FERGUSON made the call on the way to the car. He ated they called DUNN to see if there was anything else going on or anything se to do. ERICKSON stated while he was sitting in the bar after they turned after doing the robbery, he stated FERGUSON wanted to stay. He stated told FERGUSON they they needed to leave when the crowd-left the bar. He ated while in the bar, ERICKSON asked FERGUSON if he thought they had killed to victim, and FERGUSON replied yes. ERICKSON stated on the drive home, RGUSON stated he would not have committed this robbery or hurt that dividual if he had not been arrested by the police on the prior minor in session charge.

ERICKSON stated after he and FERGUSON left the bar, they drove down badway and saw all the activity behind the Columbia Tribune. He stated at at point, he stated, "It was fucked up, what we did." He stated FERGUSON ated to him, "It does not matter, I always wanted to kill someone before I sol." ERICKSON stated they only went to the scene once, and that is the sy time they saw it. He stated after that point, FERGUSON took him straight to his residence and he went to bed. He stated the following morning, a sject by the name of Scott TURNER, took him to school, but he told TURNER thing.

We asked if ERICKSON and FERGUSON had spoke about this incident more in once, and ERICKSON stated from the time the incident happened until wary 1, 2004 at a New Year's Eve party was the first time he talked to GUSON about what had happened. He stated that was the night he asked GUSON about what they had done, and FERGUSON told him if he ever told

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lybody that he would kill him too. According to ERICKSON, FERGUSON never did by what he had done with all the items that were removed from the scene. LICKSON stated he did not want to face what had happened.

We then asked more about the conversation that occurred on the New ars Eve 01/01/04. ERICKSON stated they had gone to a party at John IITWORTH'S house. ERICKSON stated he and FERGUSON went outside to have a garette. ERICKSON stated he told FERGUSON he thought we had killed the dividual at the Tribune. He stated FERGUSON stated, "No." ERICKSON stated began to become more irritated at one point and FERGUSON asked him if he was earing a wire. " ERICKSON said later on in the evening, they were in the tchen talking and FERGUSON again made the comment or statement that he always nted to kill somebody before he was 60. He stated at that time is when RGUSON told him in a very aggravated voice, "We didn't kill him. If you tell yone, I will kill you." We asked if there was anybody around when these atements were made, and ERICKSON stated an individual by the name of Kim NNETT was outside when they were talking about the murder, but stated he did t believe she said or heard anything. We asked if there was anybody else at e party who he could remember their names or anybody who could have possibly ard anything. ERICKSON stated he did not think anybody else had heard thing, but he did provide us with the following names of partygoers: John DER, Travis JEFFRIES, Eric TIMMERMAN, Nicole BENNETT, Megan ARTHUR, Tiffany RKS, and Ashley COOPER. 4.4.4.4.

We again asked ERICKSON about the clothing he was wearing that night. stated he was wearing a gray Abercrombie shirt with red lettering. We asked it happened to the coat he was wearing that night, and he stated it was a k colored reversible "puffy" coat, but he stated he later had either given by this coat or lost it at a party at Brian WALTHER'S house.

We asked ERICKSON if there were other people at By George that had seen and FERGUSON together that night, and he stated there was a girl who had n them before the crime was committed by the name of Melissa GRIGGS.

I then told ERICKSON when I interviewed him the first time, he told me ut an individual he had seen coming out the back door of the Tribune, and the first person he saw. He stated that was true, the first person he saw a white female with dark hair that he believed was curly and about shoulder gth. He said he had seen this individual with what he described as a cord ind her or near her that he could see through the crack of the door. I told when he first talked to me, he told me he thought this individual was a aning lady, and he agreed with this statement.

I then displayed the aerial satellite photo of the downtown area of imbia so ERICKSON could show the path of travel used that night. ERICKSON

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tated by pointing at the picture, he stated they started on North First Street nd either went eastbound on Walnut or eastbound on Ash. He stated they raveled to Providence where they crossed the road on Providence between the locks of Ash and Walnut. ERICKSON stated they walked up the alley way north f the Columbia Tribune where they hid behind some dumpsters. He directed my ttention to an area where there is a dumpster area that has a brick wall round it to hide the dumpsters. He stated that is where they hid prior to ttacking the victim. After the murder of HEITHOLT, ERICKSON stated they raveled southbound on North Fourth Street, they crossed Broadway ran behind ne Broadway Diner, and then traveled westbound throught Flat Branch creek, cossed that, ran between where he directed was north of the convenience store : Providence and Locust. He stated they ran between buildings there, which ould have been the Blumer's flower shop and the convenience store at that itersection. They stopped at Providence and Locust to speak with MALLORY, and men they ran in a northwesterly direction through the Osco lot back to North rst Street and back to the vehicle. This was all at the direction of ICKSON.

After obtaining ERICKSON'S statement, he was fed a sandwich and ovided several restroom breaks through this interview. After obtaining this atement, he was then transported back to the Boone County Jail where he will held until further pertaining to his case.
